Date Effective: May 1, 2021

AVAILABILITY

Available to consumers of the Cooperative located on its lines for baseball fields, softball fields, football fields, riding arenas, and other outdoor athletic or sports areas of a similar nature for uses consisting of primarily lighting and ancillary facilities; all subject to the established rules and regulations of the Cooperative.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Single or three-phase, 60 cycles, at standard available voltage supplied through one meter, used exclusively by the consumer, and not resold or shared with others. Service not applicable to standby or supplementary service.

NET MONTHLY RATE

Service Charge: \$25.00 per Consumer

Energy Charge: 17.14 Cents per kWh

MINIMUM CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge shall be the service charge plus the energy charge for all kWh consumed.

TAX CLAUSE

Billings under this rate shall be subject to the Mississippi state and municipal sales taxes and any new or additional taxes imposed upon the Cooperative by any governmental authority after the effective date of this schedule. If these new or additional taxes are allocable to the consumer on a per meter or per kWh basis, they will be added to the bill rendered hereunder directly on the same basis. If, however, the new or additional taxes are not allocable directly, then the total of such taxes paid during the preceding year will be divided by the total kWh sold during the preceding year and all kWh billed under this schedule will be adjusted by the amount thus derived.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

The above rates are net, the gross rates being one- and one-half percent (1.5%) higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid on or before the due date, the gross rates shall apply.

ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE CHARGE

To the above charges for electrical service rendered under this Rate Schedule, there shall be added an amount per kWh, based upon the Environmental Compliance Charge of the Cooperative's wholesale power supplier.

If the Environmental Compliance Charge per kilowatt-hour (kWh) of power purchased by the Cooperative changes from the base cost of 2.87 mills per kWh, the Cooperative may increase or decrease its rate by an amount sufficient to compensate for the change.

COST OF POWER ADJUSTMENT

If the cost per kilowatt-hour (kWh) of purchased power to the Cooperative changes from the base cost embedded in the Cooperative's rates, the Cooperative may increase or decrease its retail rates by an amount sufficient to compensate for the change.
